When you speak to your child use these tips to increase the speech and language skills of your child:

- Speak face to face– let them see your mouth when you talk and make eye contact.
- Add more information to things when you speak about them– for example: a cow is a farm animal that has 4 legs and we get milk from them, etc.
- Repeat– repeating things over and over helps children learn and reinforce what they are learning.
- Model good speech & language skills– use grammar correctly and say sounds they have difficulty with slowly, clearly and with emphasis.
